Confession: Confess times I have not been a Christlike model to imitate.

Thanksgiving: Thank God for Christ's sacrificial humility that caused Him to leave the glories of heaven to seek His people.

Supplication: Pray ...

- ❖ For a greater devotion to the ministry of Christ in the service of others.
- ❖ That God would use you this week to reach out to the lost in your sphere of influence in a tangible act of love.
