

Gospel of Mark: The King's Cross

Study 6: Christ, Raised Victorious

READ Mark 15:42-16:8 and **LISTEN** to the [sermon](#) by Pastor Craig.

Big idea: Christ's death and resurrection are historically certain and eternally significant. In them, Satan, sin and death are defeated and the future resurrection of His people is guaranteed.

1. When you consider your faith or when you face doubts, what do you ultimately hold on to – what is your anchor?
2. What observations do you make as to the certainty that Jesus did physically die and rise?
Jesus did physically die (15:42-47)

Jesus did physically rise (16:1-8, see also Acts 2:32)
3. How would you respond to those who theorize that Jesus didn't actually die on the cross or rise from the dead? Why is this important?
4. The resurrection is an event of cosmic proportion and enormous significance. List as many reasons as you can for why you believe this statement is true.

5. From the following verses explain the unique role Adam and Christ play in the eternal destiny of all humanity while considering the importance of the resurrection.

1 Cor 15:20-23

Rom 5:18-19

Acts 2:24

6. Read Rom 5:17 and John 11:25-26. How can the victory Jesus secured in His death and resurrection be applied to you?
7. Read Acts 17:31. In what way does the resurrection act as a warning for anyone who would reject Christ?
8. How does your own heart and personal experience give testimony to the resurrection of Christ?
9. How does knowing Christ is risen from the dead and is coming back encourage or convict you of the urgency to share Christ?
